

All information provided in this tour dossier is subject to change without prior notice. Changes would always be in consideration of your safety first and a better quality experience where possible. Overnight accommodation stops can change without prior notification, depending on road or weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances. While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of the properties listed in this dossier, these are to be used as a guideline only. We recommend that you download the most up to date version of this tour dossier one week prior to your tour departure date, however, changes are possible within 7 days prior to your tour departure.

Partaking in an adventure tour in Africa involves covering hundreds if not thousands of kilometres and our tours are as much about this journey as they are about the destinations we visit. Use your time during these drives to talk to your fellow travellers, have a drink and take note of the world passing by your window. Some roads you travel on will be smooth and easy while others could take up to an hour to cover 1 kilometre. There is just no telling what could happen with road, weather, traffic and other conditions that may exist that will either increase or decrease the amount of time you spend on the road so take your watch off, put your iPad away, turn off your phone and just relax. An average day could take anything from 5 to 14 hours, it all depends on the day... and that's only an "average"!

### PCR Testing / Requirements

All guests participating in this tour will be required to produce a **valid negative PCR test** or undertake a PCR test, prior to departure (regardless of vaccination status, for all countries visited on this tour).

- Nomad will not permit any antigen/antibody testing to be undertaken at any border crossing.
- All costs associated with PCR testing will be for the guests' own account.

### South Africa (This tour begins in South Africa)

South Africa currently requires a valid PCR negative test no more than 72 hours from the date of test, upon arrival in South Africa.

- As this tour will cross into Botswana at around lunchtime on day 1 of the tour, there will be no pre-planned testing opportunity on the morning of departure
- All guests need to ensure that their PCR results used to gain entry into South Africa will be valid when crossing over into Botswana.

### Botswana (This tour crosses the border into Botswana on day 1 of the itinerary)

Botswana requires a valid PCR test of no more than 72 hours, which means all guests are required to be in possession of a valid PCR negative test upon entry into Botswana.

- All guests will be required to test in the town of Kasane (day 5). The test will be done onsite at our overnight accommodation by a certified company.
- The cost of the PCR test ±BWP950 (Botswana Pula) will be payable in cash or by credit card at the time of the test being administered. Please ensure your credit card is in working order or you have the correct cash in Botswana Pula currency.

### Zambia (This tour has been re-routed to finish in the town of Livingstone and will cross the border on day 7 of the itinerary)

All guests entering Zambia are required to produce a negative PCR test valid no more than 72 hours. All guests will be taken to a PCR testing station in Kasane, prior to entering Zambia.

Due to the current restrictions entering Zimbabwe by road – no overnight is permitted prior to departure and therefore this tour will end in the town of Livingstone. All guests who have booked flights out of Victoria Falls Airport, will be permitted to transit into and through Zimbabwe and straight to the airport for their flights.

No testing support will be offered/arranged for guests upon arrival in Livingstone by Nomad, however, you can liaise with the front desk team at Victoria Falls Waterfront Lodge for further assistance, based on your exit date. Cost is ±USD100pp (this is payable in USD Dollar cash only). A private Doctor is called to the lodge and will do the test and all results will be uploaded to a site. Clients have to set an account set up on the below link <https://login.panabios.org/cas/login>. Private Doctors are able to get results within approximately 8 hours, however guarantee 24 hours. We strongly suggest that you liaise with the front desk as soon as you have check into the establishment.

### Zimbabwe (Only applicable if flights have been booked out of Victoria Falls Airport – transit is permitted)

All guests entering Zimbabwe are required to produce a negative PCR test valid no more than 48 hours.

- On leaving Zimbabwe, you will be required to present a negative PCR test, issued no more than 48 hours prior to boarding your flight. This is a requirement by the Zimbabwean authorities.

Nomad does not take any responsibility for PCR testing results. Nomad is acting as a facilitator to assist our guests to help obtain a test and all tests are undertaken by independent laboratories. In the event of a positive test result being received by a guest – the guest will be asked to sign off of the tour and undertake self-isolation at his/her own expense. All arrangements of self-isolation will be made by the guest. Due to additional measures put in place for PCR testing, it is possible that additional delays at border crossings will be experienced and that itinerary items will be offered earlier or later. We ask for your understanding as these delays are beyond our control.

### Day 1 – Johannesburg to Kalahari Gateway

Leaving behind the city of Johannesburg, we travel through the North-West Province to the Botswana border. After completing border formalities we continue on the Trans-Kalahari highway to our overnight stop.

After breakfast we venture deeper into the Central Kalahari and our camp in the Ghanzi district, here we will spend time getting to know the fascinating San people. The San people have long been associated with this harsh environment and this tonight we enjoy a dance evening that provides an insight into their culture of song, dance and story-telling.

### Day 3 – Greater Moremi Game Reserve Area

You will be separated from your Nomad truck for the next 2 nights and it is therefore important that you pack/gather your personal belongings which you may need, before we depart for Maun today as there is limited time in Maun for re-packing and storing. Please pack lightly and only take what you need for the following two nights. This morning we rise early and make our way towards Maun, where upon arrival in Maun you will have the opportunity to go on an optional scenic flight over the Delta (time and weather permitting). After your optional flight, you will be collected from Maun and will be transferred to the Greater Moremi Game Reserve Area in smaller safari type vehicles. This evening our guide will prepare us on what to expect for our mokoro excursion into the Okavango Delta and our game drive in Moremi Game Reserve.

### Day 4 - Greater Moremi Game Reserve Area

Heading out early, we transfer by safari vehicle, to the poling station, where we will meet the polers who will be escorting us into the Delta. The polers will steer us through the serene area of narrow, reed lined channels which open out onto beautiful lagoons. Reaching one of the many islands, a nature walk may be taken with your pole and after the walk, we return by mokoro through the channels back to the poling station. While the mokoro trail is not primarily a game viewing activity, a variety of game may be spotted in this pristine wilderness area, including elephant, giraffe, kudu, impala and zebra. After lunch, we will return to Moremi Game Reserve for our afternoon game drive which will be conducted in open 4x4 safari vehicles. The game viewing routes chosen during the afternoon by the professional guide may vary especially when high floods are experienced as certain roads may be closed or impassable.

### Day 5 – Savuti Game Reserve

The Savuti Game Reserve is a unique area bordered by the Okavango Delta to west and Chobe National Park to the east. Savuti is renowned as a big game area and known for having the largest concentrations of wildlife in Southern Africa. Today we will spend most of our day travelling through the Savuti Game Reserve in search of the species that roam the plains. Offering habitats from wetland, open water to the grasslands and Savannah woodland, we hope to see as many species of fauna and flora possible. This afternoon we arrive on the banks of the Chobe River and will be re-united with our Nomad truck in the town of Kasane.

You will return to camp in time for lunch and a quick siesta before we head out in the afternoon to explore the Chobe National Park from the river, enjoying a leisurely boat cruise which allows us an up close and personal experience with the many elephants that frequent the river in the afternoons.
