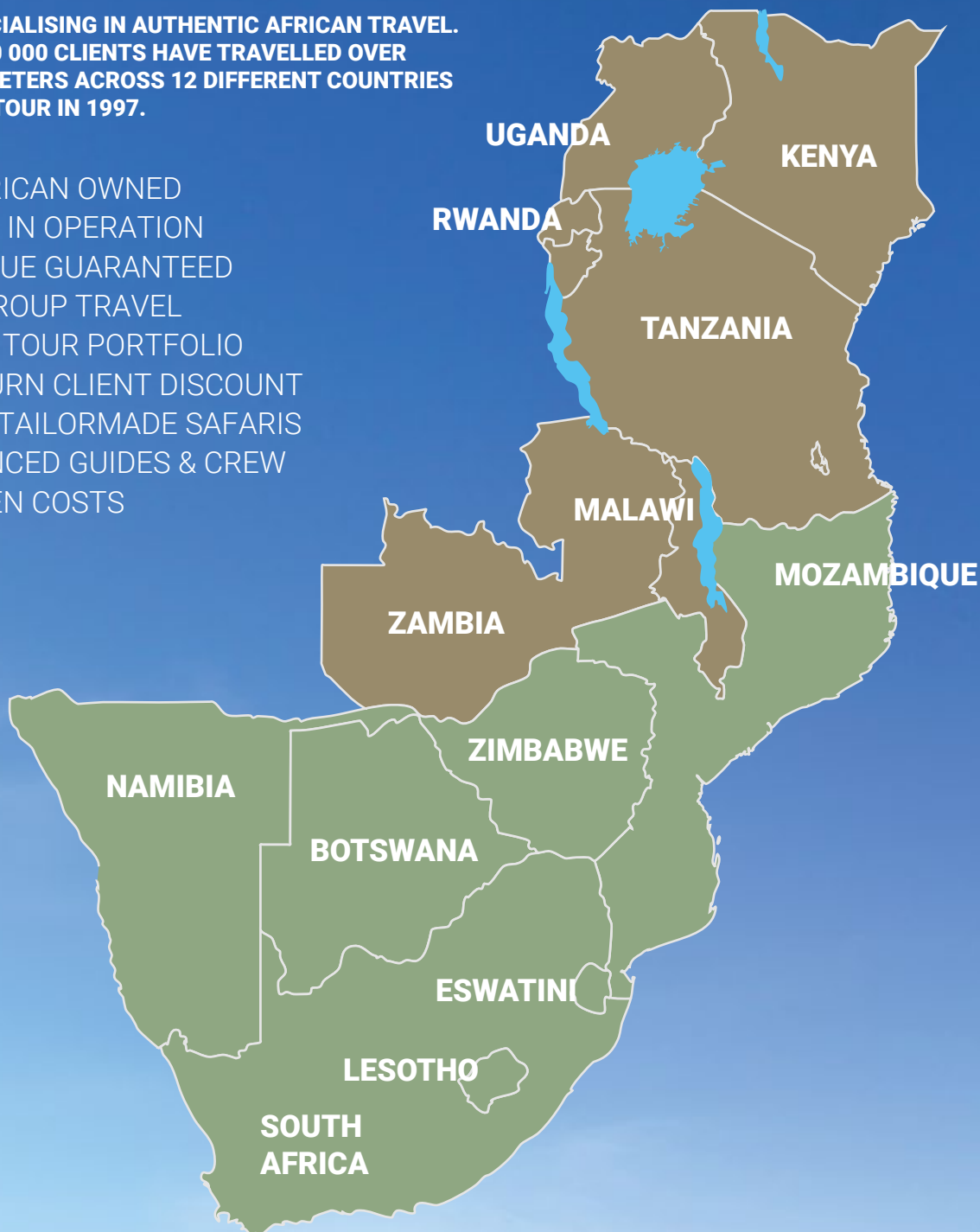

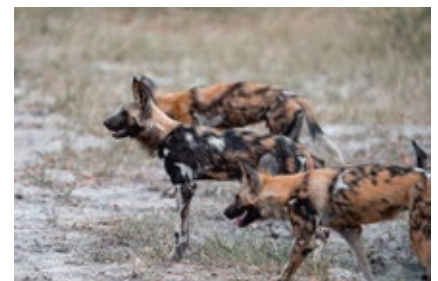
PLACES.
